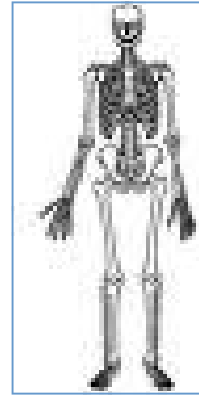


This week year 6 have been planning and writing a story focusing on how they can create an emotional response in the reader and incorporate complex sentences in their writing.

Bonus words: Olympic, athlete, positive.

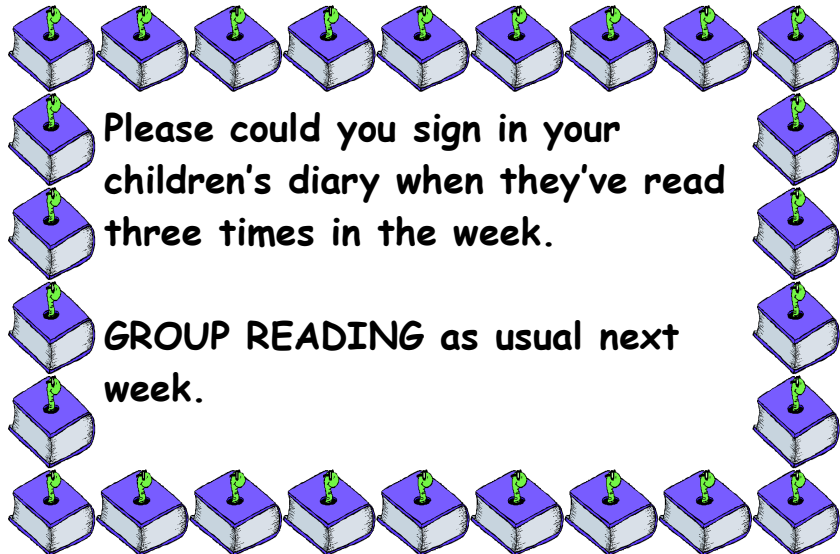
Just to let you know...
