Curriculum

The children have worked incredibly hard on their Diary extract, editing and re-editing their work. They have been thinking carefully about sentence starters, adequate detail and correct punctuation. In Maths we have started revisiting the four operations and different written methods for recording these calculations. This week we have mainly looked at addition and subtraction and next week we will be working on multiplication and division, developing an understanding of their relationship to each other and \pm . The children are continuing to make super progress with constructing and interpreting bar charts, often where the intervals or symbols represent a group of units.
