Inventors party. Share inventions with year group.

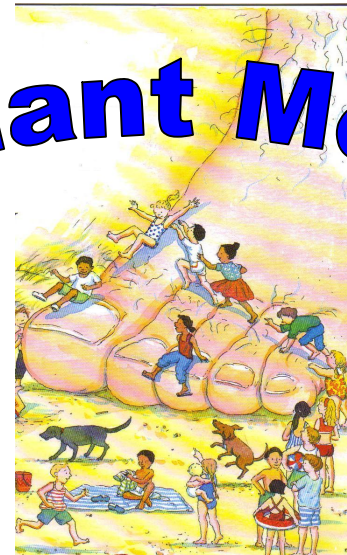
