Compare homes from different
periods. In the Role Play area,
children to make a room from
a house/castle linked to
literacy. Children to use
artifacts such as iron, mangle,
carpet beater.

Science

Identifying different light sources
Investigate and test which torch
shines the brightest and /or the
furthest
Make black boxes with a peephole
Discuss the benefits of reflective
clothing- when should we use it?

Numeracy

Measures and time- to tell
the time to the half hour or
hour on an analogue clock.
Solve problems using hour
and half past.
Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10
from a given number.
Place value, ordering and
estimating.
Addition and subtraction and
applying this in simple
problem solving.
Money and "real life"
problems – finding totals to
20p and above using exact
coins.
Fast recall of number bonds
to 10 and 20.
Combination of indoor and
outdoor areas.
