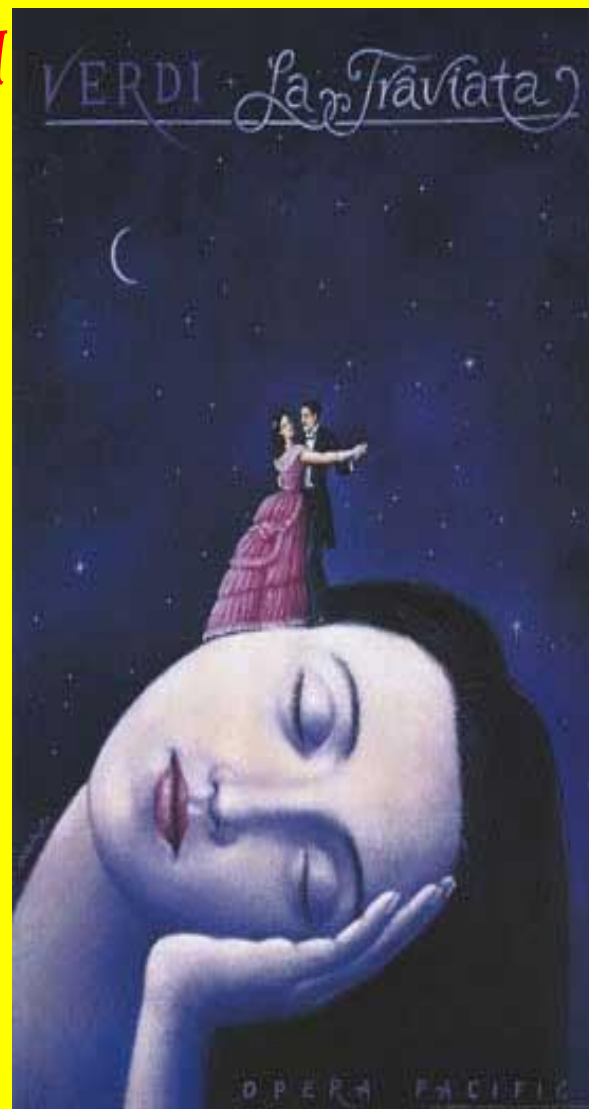


Opera of the Week

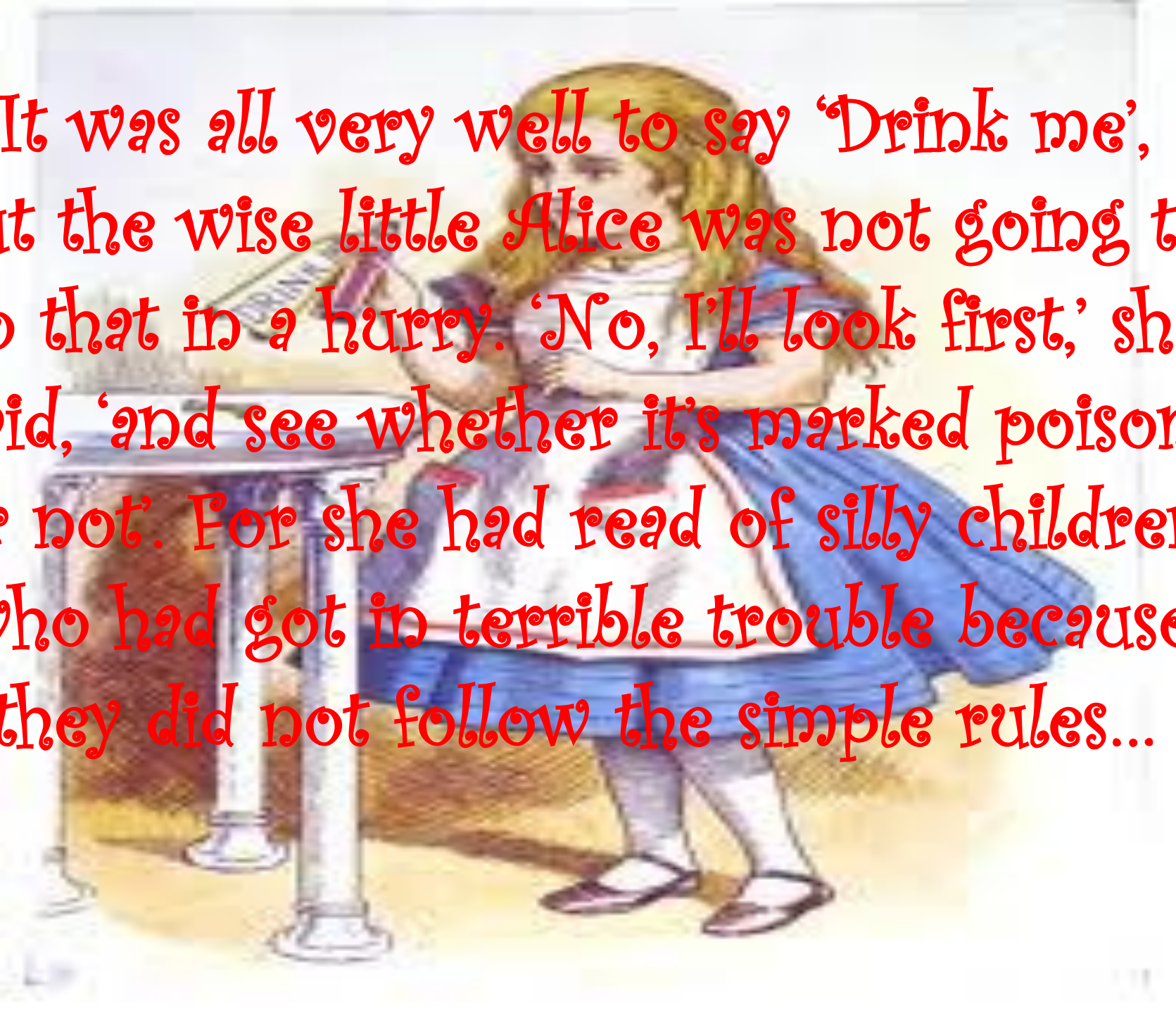
Violetta, a French courtesan throws a party and meets the nobleman Alfredo who proclaims his love for her, but she initially rejects him.

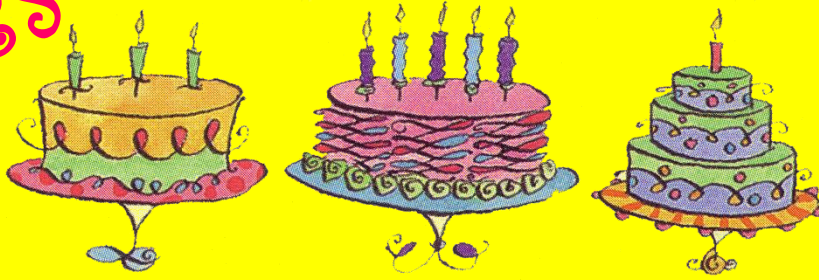

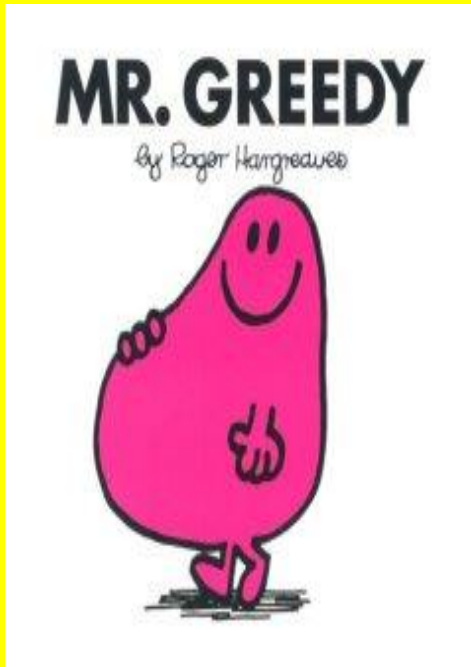
