This week the children have created their own evacuee character. We have focussed on creating a back story and looking at some of the experiences they may have had. Ask your child about their character!

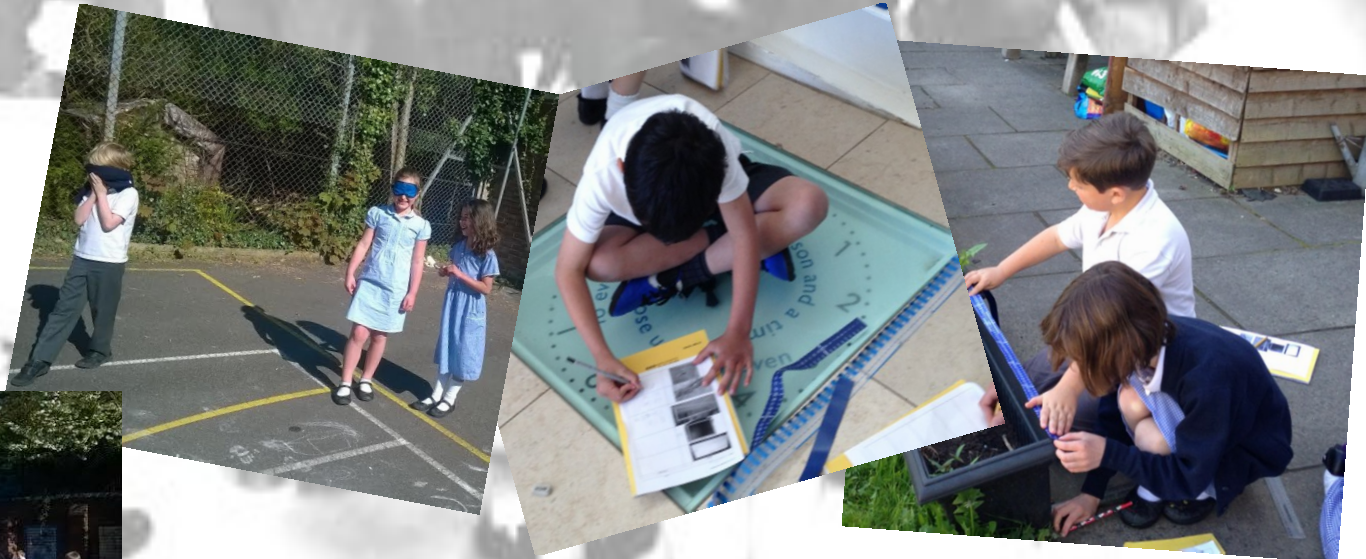
Reminders and Notices
