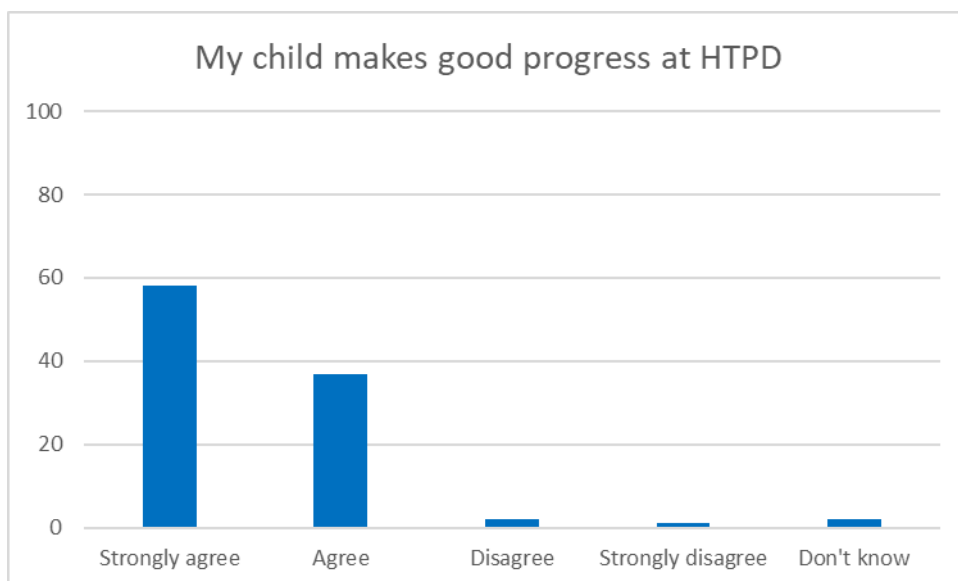
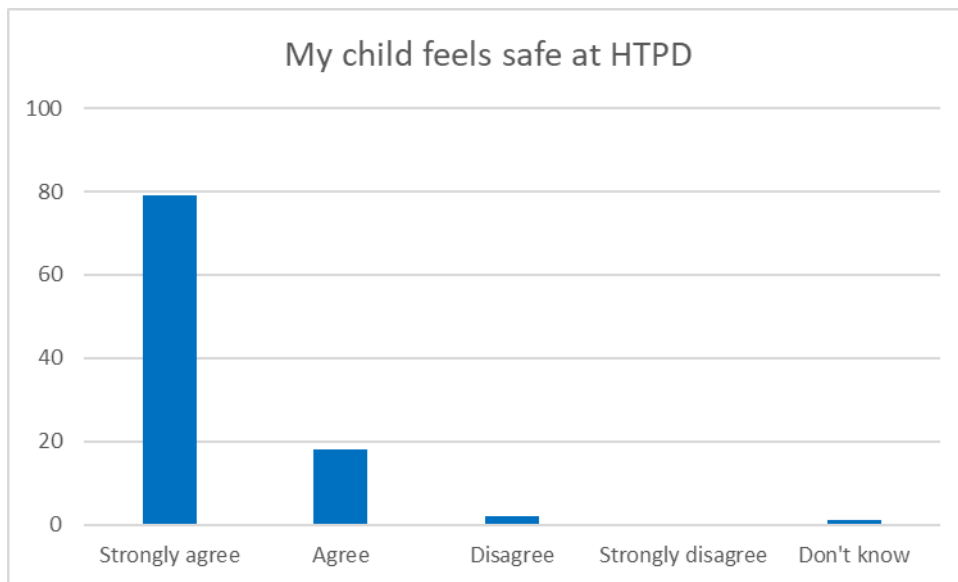
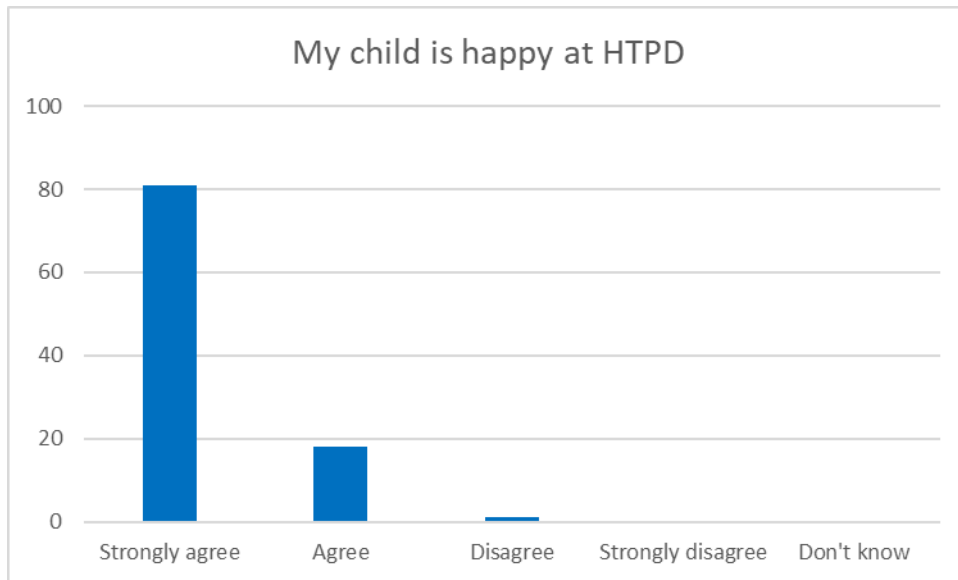


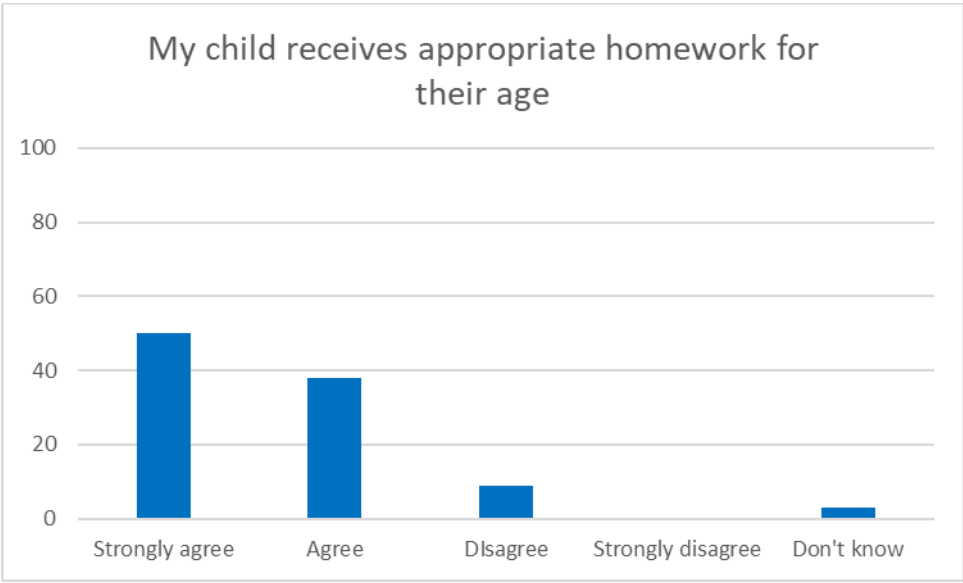
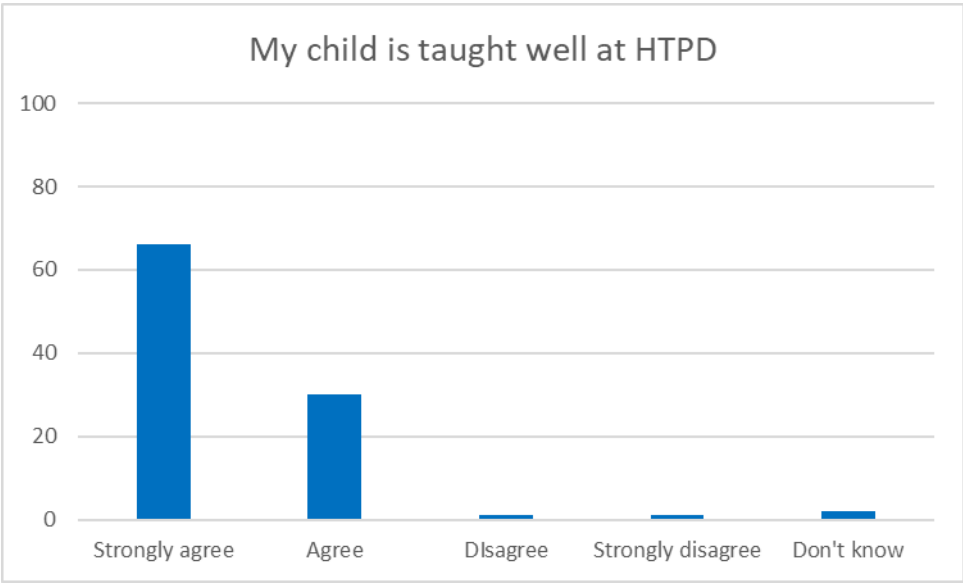
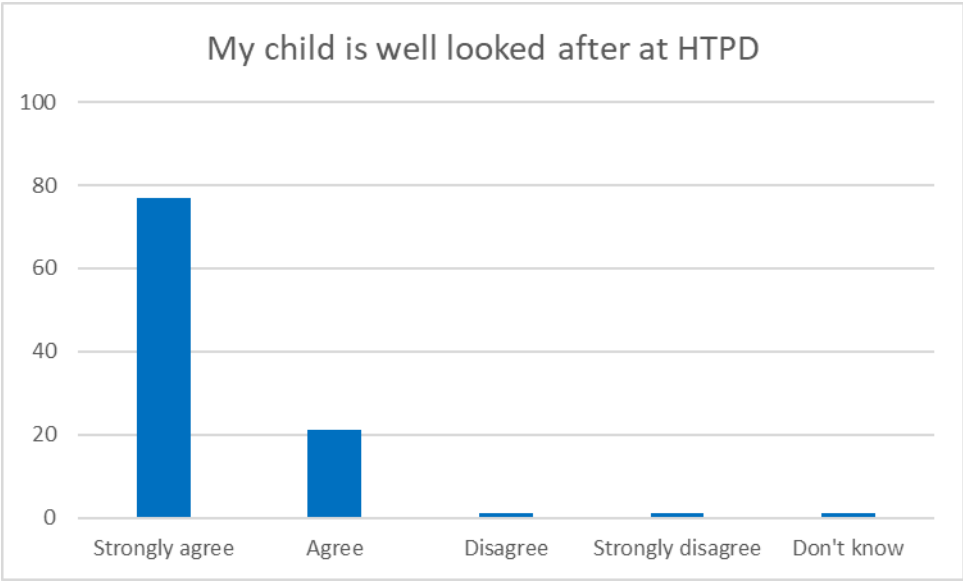
Results of 2019 Parent Survey and 2018 Ofsted Parent View

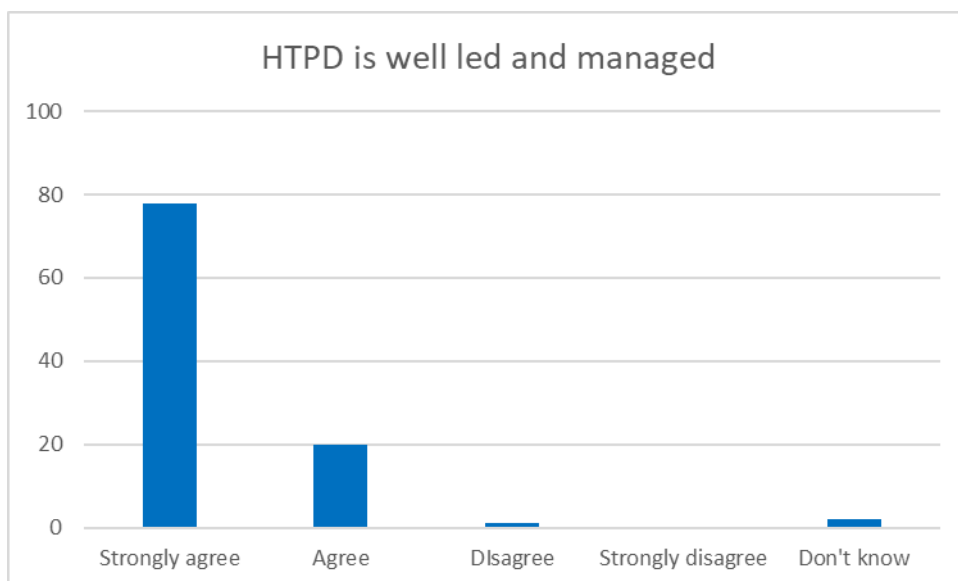
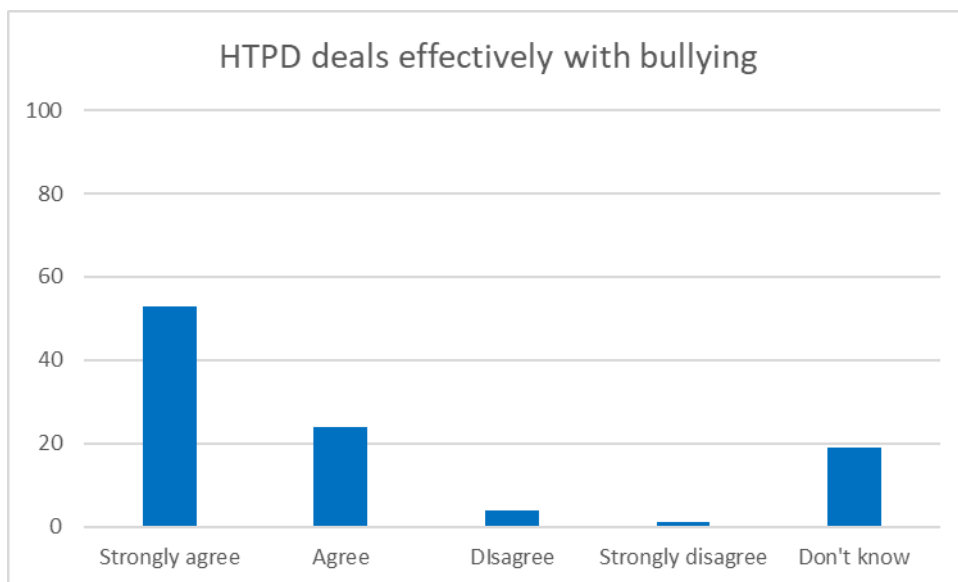
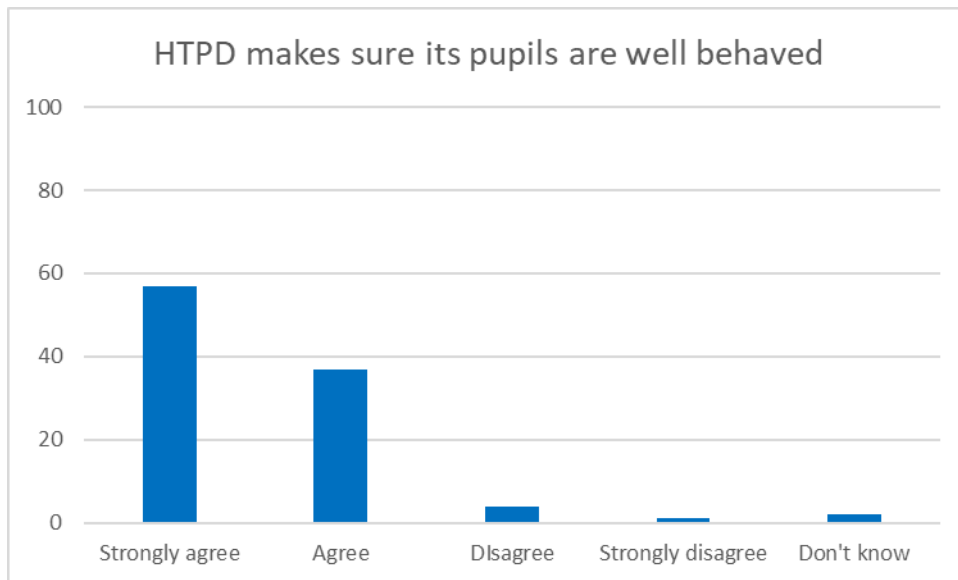
Summary and key findings

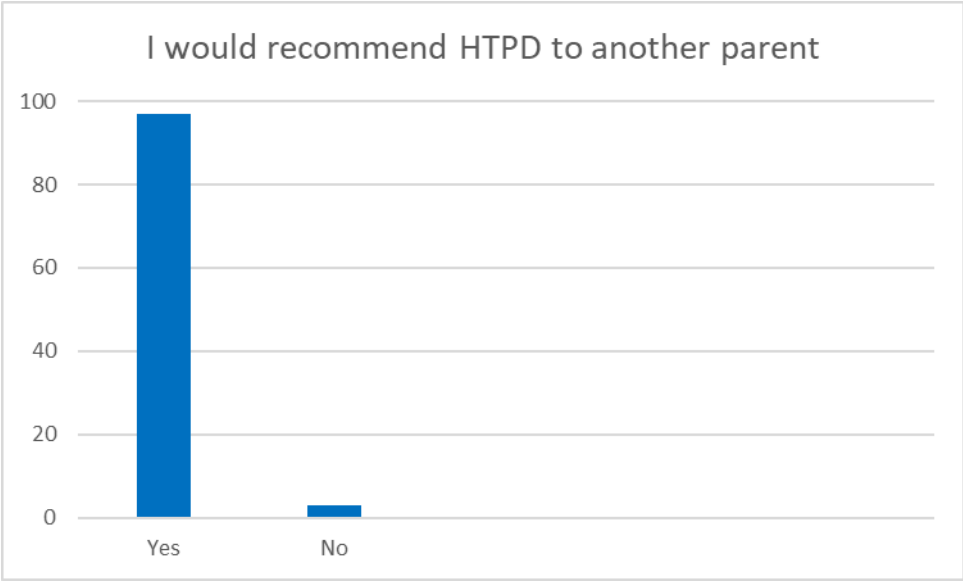
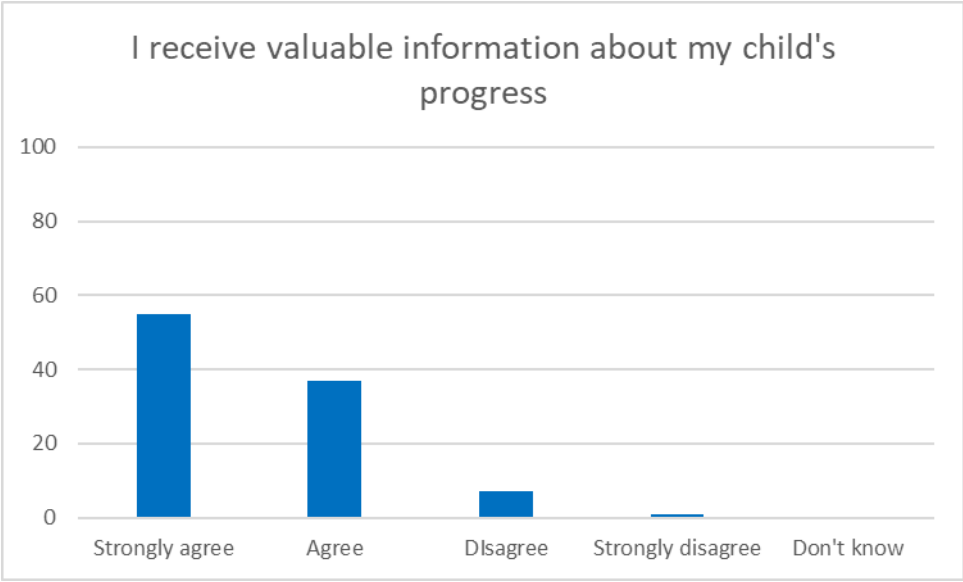
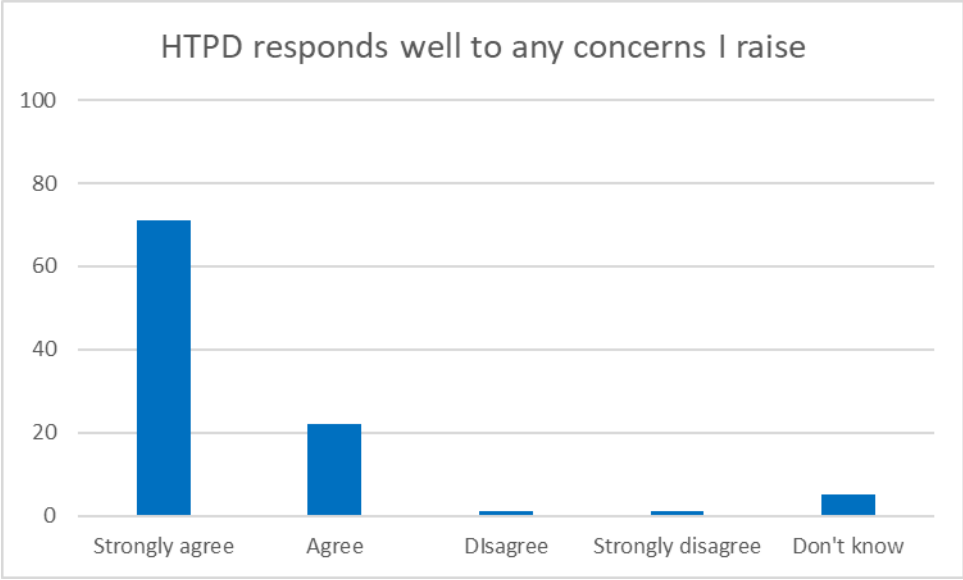
- There were 169 responses to Ofsted Parent View gathered from junior school families, and 78 responses to our own internal survey from across all year groups.
- 97% of families would recommend the school to another parent.
- There was an overwhelmingly positive response to questions about children feeling happy, safe, being well looked after, taught well and making good progress.
- Similarly questions about our values, assemblies impacting on wellbeing, the opportunities to develop character and care for others, and our focus on healthy living generated very positive responses.
- A small number of parents (7%) feel that we could communicate information about children's progress more effectively and this will be discussed to ensure that all parents receive valuable updates. Please do ask if you feel that you need more information.
- Less than 10% of parents felt dissatisfied with the homework that we set.
- Whilst concerns about bullying are very uncommon, any child who experiences bullying is one too many. Again please do not hesitate to speak to me if you have any unresolved concerns.
- The response to the question about our approach to reducing sugar intake was very interesting with 54% of parents requesting that we do not do anything further to limit sugar consumption at school.
- We were grateful for so many individual comments about the ways that we develop character, how our Christian ethos permeates the school and how this impacts on children's educational outcomes. We were encouraged that so many parents valued how assemblies impact the children positively. Parents from all faiths and none reflected on how the children were being taught empathy, respect and love. Receiving feedback like this is so helpful as we plan for the school's ongoing distinctiveness.
- Thank you for all the useful comments, feedback and suggestions. The school governors and senior leaders will find them invaluable as we meet to consider the school's next steps.

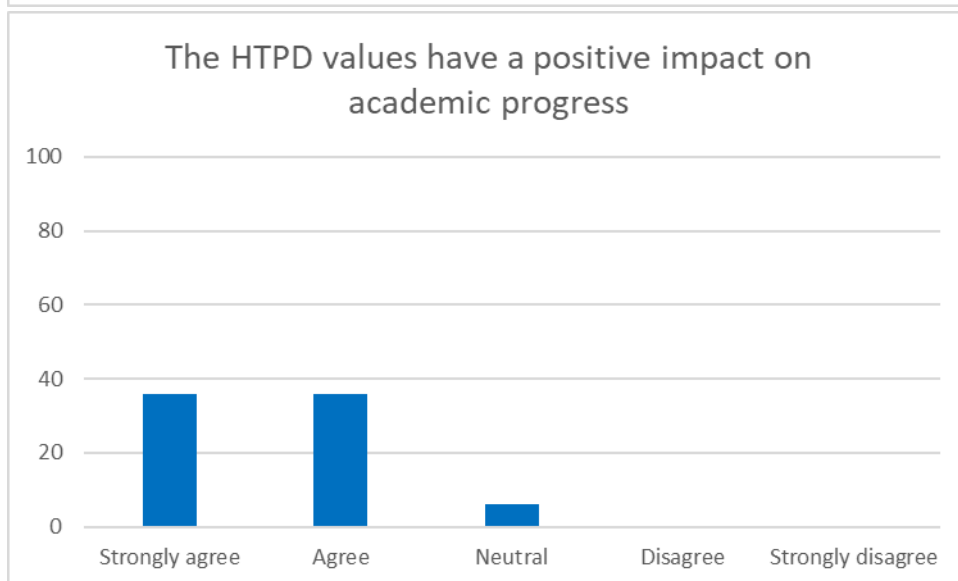
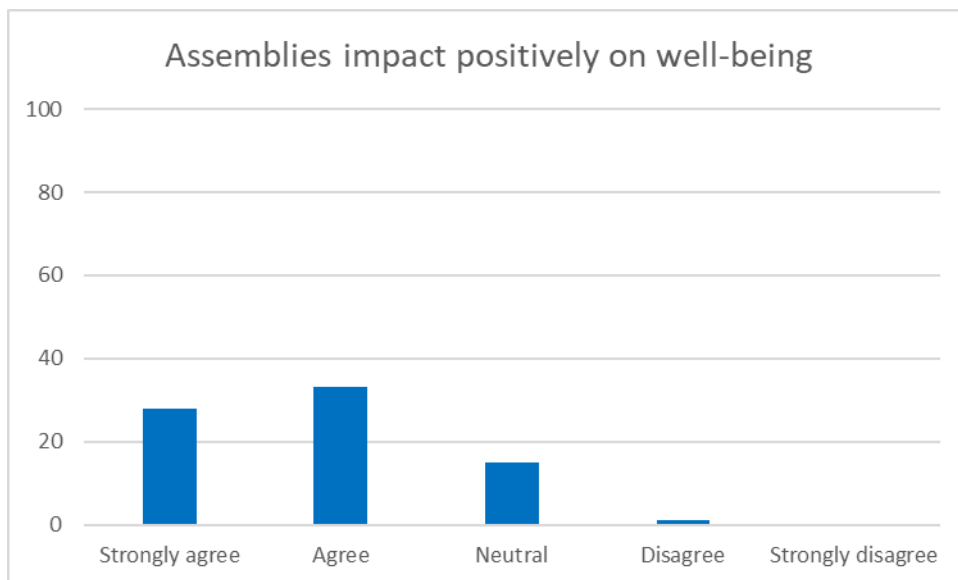
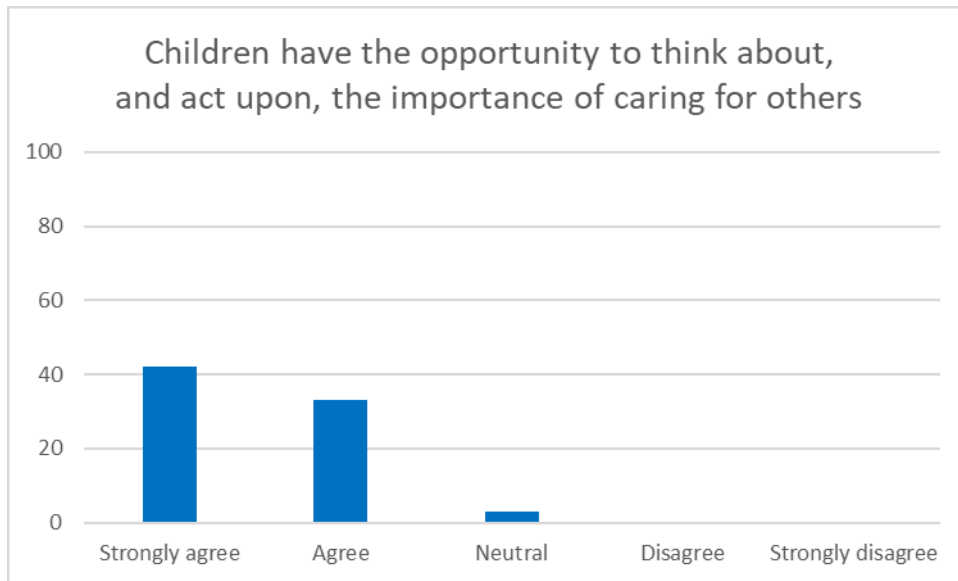


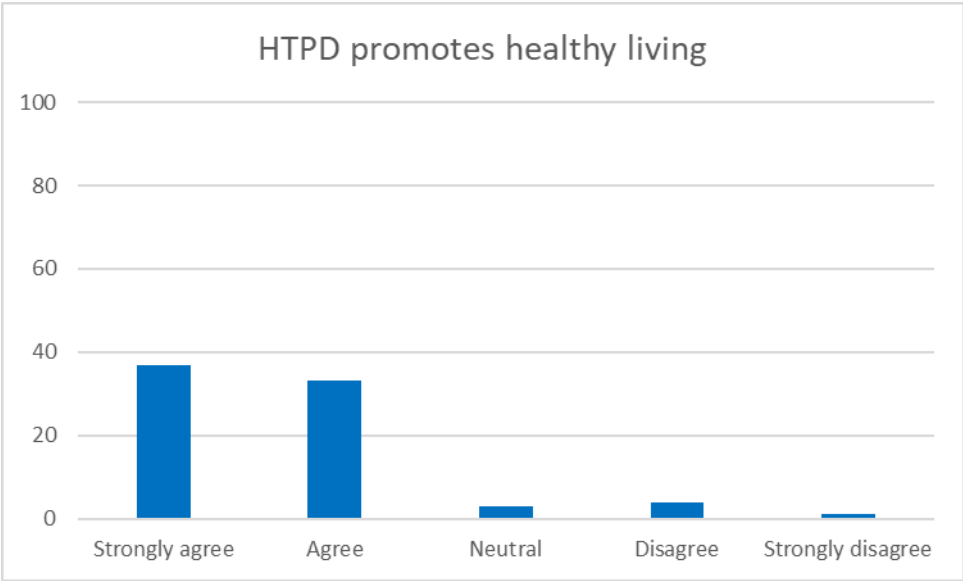
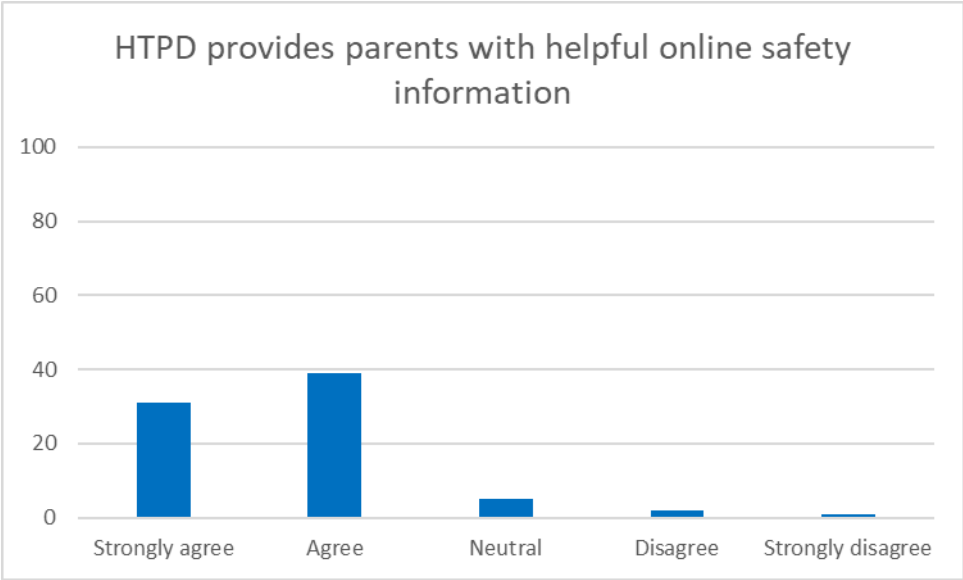
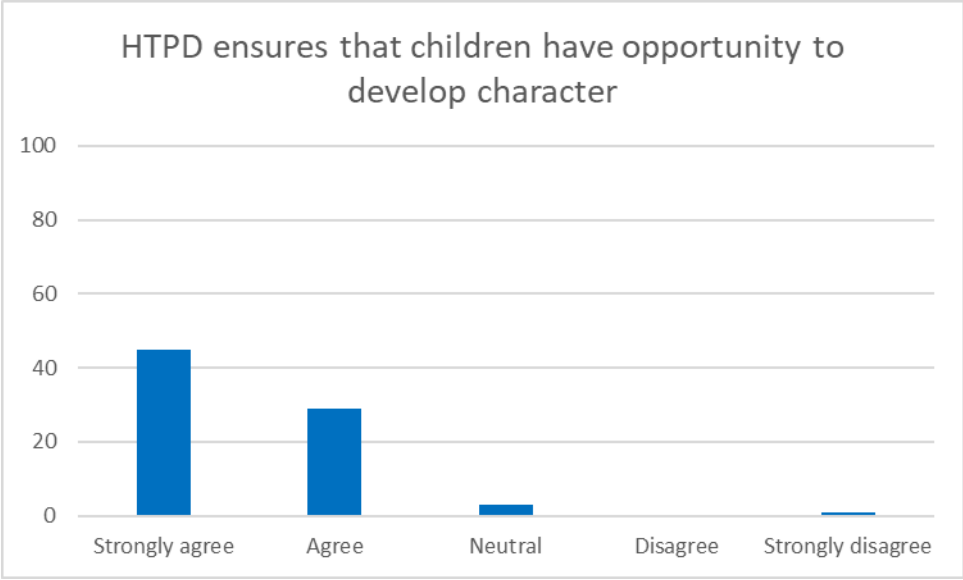






Parent Survey based on 78 responses from across all year groups (these charts display actual numbers rather than percentages):
