

Ancient Egypt- Spring Term 2

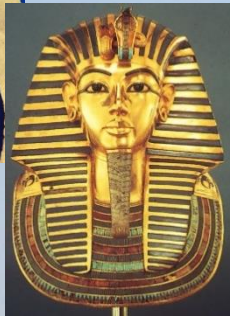
Music

Singing – Siyahamba

History

Discuss and compare what features Ancient Civilisations had in common by
looking at the Indus, Ancient Egyptians, Sumer and Shang civilisations.
Plot these Ancient Civilizations on a timeline and compare them to life in
Britain in the same time period.

Understand the importance of the River Nile in the settlement of
Ancient Egypt.

Investigate how the Nile helped the Egyptians become innovative and
successful farmers.

Explore the importance of Religion and shared beliefs in Ancient
Egyptian Life.

Discover the Ancient Egyptian writing system of Hieroglyphics, by
studying the Rosetta stone and creating Cartouches.

Understand the relevance of archaeological clues and evidence in
helping our understanding of the past.

Appreciate the process of mummification.

Look at and critically compare the evidence surrounding the building of
the pyramids

English

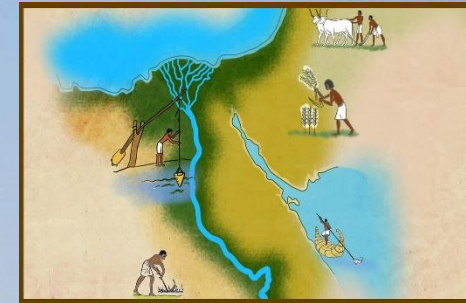
Write an Egyptian Myth experimenting with description and figurative
